### **SECTION FIVE**

Write an essay on your “contribution to the well-being and care of the elderly” or “your help with the problems confronting the elderly.” This essay should include whether your involvement was as a result of a course you took or a project you did. If it was neither, explain why you became involved. The essay should also tell why you think you deserve the scholarship. Don’t be modest.

Please include two or three recommendations from people who can substantiate your positive contribution to elderly people.
