Enrollment at the Phoenix Program remained steady this school year with a total of 32 students served. In this era of declining school populations across the state and at Spaulding the Phoenix Program has seen continued demand for its services.

Nineteen Phoenix students will graduate with the Class of 2011. All of these graduates needed Phoenix to complete their high school education or returned to school after having dropped out.

The Phoenix mid-year graduation was well attended and has turned out to be very important for parents and families of our students. We at Phoenix appreciate the support of both administration and school board members at this event and throughout the school year.
